Satisfying the Radford University Core Curriculum (general education) Program

In accordance with the State Policy on Transfer, students who transfer to Radford University from a Virginia Community College will have satisfied Radford University's Core Curriculum if they have earned an Associate of Arts degree in

<u>Music</u>; if they are able to earn such a degree by successfully completing at a Virginia Community College courses remaining for the degree concurrently with the first semester of enrollment at Radford University; or if they will earn the associate's degree as a result of credit earned during the first semester of enrollment at Radford University, up to a maximum of 10 hours.

 ² Satisfactory completion of the MUS courses listed here will transfer as Music Electives. In order for Applied Lesson classes to count towards a Bachelor's degree in Music, students must complete a successful audition into the Department of Music and screening jury for that performance area.
- ³ Transfer students accepted into the Department of Music may apply up to four Large Ensemble credits towards their degree.
- ⁴ All transfer students that wish to apply any earned credits in Theory as well as Ear Training/Sight Singing toward the major in music, must successfully pass placement tests in these subjects.

Other Notes

Transfer students seeking teacher licensure in music must take all other major degree requirements in music at Radford University. In order to receive a Bachelor's degree in Music from Radford University, students must complete at least 120 credit hours. Students must complete at least 45 hours at Radford University, including at least half of the hours in the Music major, and 30 of the last 39 credit hours must be completed at Radford University. For any course to count for transfer, it must be completed with a grade of "C" or higher
